AWARDS ARE JUDGED ON CURRENT YEAR APRIL 1 THROUGH MARCH 31

NOTE: All Florida State Council awards based on a "per member" basis will be determined by the actual number of members for whom the chapter pays state council dues by March 1st according to the Florida State Council Treasurer records. See Article III, Section 6, Florida State Council Bylaws

The following award **ENTRY FORMS MUST** be filled out and sent to the Florida State Council Awards Chairman listed in the front of this yearbook. *The current year's entry forms* <u>MUST BE USED</u>. Send all entries in at one time with the form at the end of the awards pages, listing the submissions.

Any new chapter (chartered after December) is encouraged to enter awards, since judging is based on availability offered, rather than quantity, i.e. attending 3 out of 3 meetings, socials, etc. is as good as 6 out of 6 or 10 out of 10.

Award entry forms must be **POSTMARKED BY APRIL 10TH FOLLOWING THE CLOSE OF THE CURRENT YEAR**. One copy is required for each category unless indicated that no form is necessary. **All entries** <u>must</u> be signed by the Awards **Chairman, Chapter President or other Chapter officer.**

<u>Candidates for individual awards cannot sign their own entry forms</u> (entry will be disqualified).

Print the entry forms to use for each entry. You may enter two or more candidates for Outstanding Pledge, Individual Member Philanthropic, or "What ESA Means to Me." A separate entry form must accompany each entry.

Winners will receive a certificate (from the Florida State Council) and an award as decided by the sponsor of the award; with the exception of the "Outstanding Chapter" award which is a traveling trophy and the "Outstanding Youth" awards (1 middle school and 1 high school) that each receive a cash award.

Helpful Hints for Awards

- Take time in your chapter to look over each award. If you have any questions, please contact the State Awards Chairman or a member of the PPA.
- Check out the Educational and Athenian Awards. Include the resources and comments when you give an educational. By following the setup of these awards, it gives you the format of presentation.
- When you look over the Philanthropic awards consider if the hours or money you claimed were in the name of/or through ESA. Could you have worn an ESA volunteer nametag during your participation? If not, you might rethink for whom you were volunteering.
- Be honest with yourself and with your entry. There are no ESA awards police, just your conscience.

- 6. The student shall submit letters of recommendation from three (3) citizens of the community who are not related to the student (Example: Minister, Teacher, Scout Leader, etc.)

Outstanding Senior High Youth Award AWARD GUIDELINES

- 1. The winner of the Epsilon Sigma Alpha Outstanding Senior High Youth Award shall receive the ESA Foundation Outstanding Youth Award Grant in the amount of \$1,000.00 provided:
 - The International Council (IC) Board representative notifies the ESA Foundation by May 1st. There are adequate funds to give the grant in the fund account by April 1st. The winner meets the criteria established for the Outstanding Youth Award.
 - The award, in the amount of \$1,000.00 grant, may be applied toward tuition, registration, fees, books, supplies and equipment, dormitory fees, or any other college fees or academic expensed. The award shall be made payable to the recipient and the institution of higher learning of the winner's choice. If the college or university of choice is changed, the Scholarship Director of the ESA Foundation should be notified immediately. The check should be returned and another check issued by the ESA Foundation to the correct college or university.
 - It is understood that the grant award will be held in escrow should the recipient not be a high school graduate or ready to continue his/her education. The ESA Foundation shall provide a certificate for the recipient, which will be redeemable for the designated grant at the time a college is selected.
- 2. The Outstanding Youth will receive a certificate from the International Council of Epsilon Sigma Alpha.

OUTSTANDING SENIOR HIGH YOUTH AWARD APPLICATION

The name of this award shall be known as the **Epsilon Sigma Alpha (ESA) Outstanding Senior High Youth Award.**

The International Council (IC) of ESA shall select the Outstanding Senior High Youth based upon the following criteria:

Scholastic Ability

The applicant shall be a senior high student who meets the academic qualification:

Have a minimum 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 Grade Scale

The applicant shall provide a copy of the most recent to verify grades.

Character and Leadership Skills

The applicant shall provide the judging committee with two (2) letters of recommendation. At least one recommendation shall be from a teacher or school official. Recommendations shall not be submitted from members of the applicant's family. Recommendations should be originals of recent (current) year.

The applicant shall provide a personal essay. The essay topic shall be, **"What is the definition of an outstanding individual and how do I personally meet this definition?"** There is no specified length requirement; however, typewritten essays are preferred. The essay must be an original, which is signed and dated by the applicant.

Rules and Regulations

The winner of the Outstanding Senior High Youth Award will be chosen annually. A person may receive this award only **one** time. A person may apply for this award as many times as they wish as long as they meet the criteria. No special consideration will be given to an applicant who makes a second or third entry for this award. The deadline for submitting applications will be March 1st and must be sent to the International Council Youth Award Chair by the specified date. **All necessary information must be included with the application form at that time.**

The applicant must apply for this award to his/her individual State ESA Youth Award Chair Postmarked No Later Than February 1st. (If no State

Chair directly to the IC Awards Chair.). The application with all attachments, if approved, will be forwarded to the International Council Awards Chair and committee for approval and judging.

A letter will be sent to the winner (only) after judging has been completed and no later than May 15th.
